IQ TRIVIA

To reinvent the education system and give students a break from traditional classroom learning there is a dire need to revive the quiz culture. Besides the obvious academic benefits of expanding a student's knowledge and exploring new skills at an early age, quizzes redefine the education system in significant ways.

This year at SIGMA PSI 1.0 students' intellectual abilities will be put to test. A category based on questions about insignificant facts of history, popular culture, art and science, aptly named IQ Trivia, has been included.

Round 1:

The first round of IQ TRIVIA will test contestants' basic knowledge on topics in history, popular culture, art and science through a series of challenging MCQs and structural questions. Contestants will be tested on their spontaneity and accuracy in answering the questions in the field of current affairs.

A category that will consist of 20 Multiple Choice Questions, to be solved in 30 minutes, will test the ability of the participants to solve tricky problems under pressure. This will be the most competitive round of all the categories; the top four teams will qualify for Round 2.

Note: Only 2 contestants from each team will be allowed to participate.

Round 2:

This round will comprise of Five questions about Current Affairs having four multiple options, which will carry five marks each.

Round 3:

This round will have Renowned Personality Round (RPR), options will not be provided and questions will carry 10 marks each. Two hints will be provided for each question, whereas, two marks will be deducted for every hint asked incase a team avails this option.

Round 4 (Final Round): This will have direct questions having no options, which will carry 15 marks each.
